"It's important to remember that alone with ereat style, homeowners want functionality," said Blue Haven's Lazlo. Once maintenance options are resolved, pools comfort and relocation.



"It's endless what people can do today," said Brett Madden, co-owner of Custom Clear Pools remodeling business, owner of Tile Rescue and manager of Clear Pool.

It's also important for consumers to know that pool companies are unregulated in Houston, so Marquise's Smith suggests knowing the credentials and experience of a pool firm before you hire it. Also, check for Better Business Bureau complaints and a published reference list. Find out when the company registered with the county in order to see how long it's been in business.

Taking shape

Once customers have selected a company and/or designer, they can begin to explore aerebenic factors such as shape and size. Ideal Pools takes a unique approach to helping customers visualize their product. "We draw the pool in the house on a computer," owner and provident loc Forbert said. "We let the customers do what they want, and we're there to help them along the way."

hen people ask Greg Mayor what he does for a living, the Bedrock Pools master sculptor says he creates the estoric and the extraordinary.

Mayor's Houston-based Genegary won't even take clients who want traditional pools. Each of its products is custom made. "The more interesting and the more unique, the more we like

in." Mayor said.

After extensive interviews with the client, Mayor's been known to work 30 hours at a time to bring images from his imagination to life, including quite a few sea creatures lately. Most special requests are based on aenthetics, but Mayor also adds features for comfort, such as theraportic seas with humber surrour, armounts and nearly drink holders.

Interest in the way-out and wild seems to be increasing among area pool customers. USA Pool & Spas owner Chris Esposito is putting the finishing touches on a custom pool in Cypress that includes a cold spa area with a table in it and a 6-foor-wide. 15-foor-long bridge over it.

The grotton basically are large, underwater rooms that can hold a waterproof TV, underwater speakers or lighting. "People can go in there, relax and watch a ball game," sid Smith.

Grottos are popular with people who entertain, along with swim-up bars and tables. Other "out-there" possibilities include floating columns, urns or boulders.

Special lighting features include fiber optic mushrooms from Marquise and rotating color wheels from Anthony & Sylvan.

Jay Bellar, Anthony & Sylvan general manager, said, "The system has four colors, which create a new spectrum as they mix. You can stop it on an individual color or keep it changing. For Christmas the pool can be green and the spa red."

Pool features also can add a creative touch to exercise. Owners can add assim jest that create water pressure for swimming in place, Bellar said. And pool owners can place handrails beneath the water for holding on and kicking in place.

Wild for water features

For many people, the addition of water features truly makes the pool. "Waterfalls can make a huge difference," said Radigh Jenkins, prosident of AMC Peat, Dot & Lewn. "Its not just the visuals six be sound of the water flowing." Customers can opt for water flowing over bricks, most rock, linear artificial material designed to have a specific look, be said. Sheer descent waterfalls flow straight down over a smooth surface.

According to Contempo's Roth, the No. 1 water feature in Houston is the spa. A standard spa has a straight will and some bubbles, but customers can customize it with sloped walls and strategically placed water jets.

Additional water feature options include weeping rocks to the side of the pool, dock jets that shoot water into the pool, bubble jets in the pool, vanishing edges that send water into each basins and beach entries with gradual inclines, Ideal Pools' Foebert said.

A once-common pool element that's making a departure is the diving board. ABC's Jenkins noted that the "diving rock" is becoming a popular alternative. "It despit shoot out as far as the diving board, and it's more aesthetically pleasing." he said.

Once all of the pool claments are in place, homeowners can tie; them in nearly to an ultra-manageable control system. "You can control the whole pool from inside the house: heater, lights, waterfall, everything," Forbeser said. "Homeowners even can activate the controls from their cell phones on the way home."
